



Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Policy

Introduction

The UK Modern Slavery Act 2015 stipulates that businesses are required to publish a statement each financial year demonstrating an understanding of the Act and the steps that are being taken to ensure that modern slavery and human trafficking are not taking place, whether within the business or in any way.

Modern slavery and human trafficking in all their various forms and guises are a crime in the UK and much of the world. They are a violation of fundamental human rights and as such Unique Support for Unique People (US4UP) will not tolerate or condone slavery or human trafficking in any part of the business. We have a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery and human trafficking and are totally committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all activities and business relationships and we expect all other business partners to commit to the same.

US4UP will not knowingly support or deal with any business involved in slavery or human trafficking.

Due Diligence

US4UP is satisfied from its own due diligence that there is no evidence of any act of modern slavery or human trafficking within its own business.
