



Child Protection Policy

Unique Support for Unique People (US4UP) is fully committed to safeguarding the welfare of all children in its care. It recognises the responsibility to promote safe practice and to protect children from harm, abuse and exploitation.

For the purposes of this policy and associated procedures a child is recognised as someone under the age of 18 years. US4UP will work together to embrace difference and diversity and respect the rights of children and young people. This document outlines Unique Support for Unique Peoples commitment to protecting children.

These guidelines are based on the following principles:

- The welfare of children is the primary concern.
- All children, whatever their age, culture, disability, gender, language, racial origin, socio-economic status, religious belief and/or sexual identity have the right to protection from all forms of harm and abuse.
- Child protection is everyone's responsibility.
- Children have the right to express views on all matters which affect them, should they wish to do so.
- Organisations shall work in partnership together with children and parents/carers to promote the welfare, health and development of children.

Unique Support for Unique People will:

- Promote the health and welfare of children by providing opportunities for them to take part in activities safely.
- Respect and promote the rights, wishes and feelings of children.
- Promote and implement appropriate procedures to safeguard the well-being of children and protect them from abuse.
- Adopt best practice to safeguard and protect children from abuse and to reduce risk to themselves.
- Abide by this Child Protection Policy and other Policies and Procedures.
- Respond to any allegations of abuse to children in line with this Policy and Safeguarding procedures.
- Observe guidelines issued by local Child Protection Committees for the protection of children.
- Regularly monitor and evaluate the implementation of this Policy and Safeguarding Procedures.
- Follow changes in legislation and guidance on the protection of children or in accordance with any changes within Unique Support for Unique People.
- Report any issues or concerns raised about the protection of children within Unique Support for unique People.
- Review all policies every year.
